**New Announcements:**

**People who drive the large trucks into the Northwest Territories carrying important supplies, need to be able to use bathrooms, showers, and buy food at businesses while on their trip.** The Chief Public Health Officer is asking businesses to open up washrooms and showers owners had before so that truck drivers can use them, and also to please keep selling food to the truck drivers. There are cleaning rules that businesses can follow to keep safe so that they can give the truck drivers the things they need to do their important job. To learn more visit:
